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Federal Plugin for Title I 2016-17 EOY and ESSR Security Access

A federal plug-in that enables NCDPI to run the 2016-17 Title I EOY process will be deployed into PowerSchool this weekend. This plug-in also includes corrections to the Eligible Schools Summary Report (ESSR). Users will not see any changes.

More End of Year Reminders

The 2015-2016 EOY will start Thursday, June 30, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. All work will be completed before 6:00 a.m., Monday, July 11, 2016. Users will be notified when the system is returned to service. Make

sure all required state compliance reports are completed in advance of the June 30, 5:00 p.m. shutdown. Delays in these reports will impede the state processing and increase downtime.

Also, please be reminded that all LEAs and charter schools must run EOY during the state EOY window (June 30 – July 11) regardless of end date. Running EOY early will cause issues and could jeopardize the state EOY timeline.

Graduation Date Reminder:

As a reminder, the GDV report will look for a student's graduation date in the "diploma issued" field on the student academics page. This date should be the date the student completed his/her graduation requirements. Graduate classifications (regular, early, or summer) are determined and reported on the GDV based on the dates entered in this field. Note: This date for a regular graduate should be between the exit date (final day of school) and June 30. Diploma issued dates earlier than this date cause errors with the e-transcript service.

Student Rank:

In order to ensure proper EOY processing and Prior-year reporting, all secondary students must have a rank run at least one time during the school year. NCDPI will not be force running rank at EOY. LEAs should ensure this step is taken prior to the EOY cutoff date (June 30, 5 p.m.). This rank is automatically copied into the historical rank table for each student which is used in various queries and for transcript purposes.

EOY Contact:

Each LEA and charter must submit a ticket with the subject "2016 EOY Contact" to the Home Base Support Center indicating their 24/7 EOY contact and their choice to either run EOY or have NCDPI run the process on their behalf. The ticket should include:

- Name
- Phone and alternate phone numbers
- Email address
- LEA name and number
- Whether the LEA/charter intends to run EOY (LEA EOY) or wants DPI to execute EOY (DPI EOY).

New Course Code Master Lists

- There were two different course codes for BUS 228 Business Statistics. The non-CTE course code (0C335X0) has been removed for 2016-17, but the CTE course code (BX255X0) will remain available.

- FC102X0 Teen Living and FC105X0 Teen Living Honors were made unavailable beginning in 2016-2017. This course is being replaced by FC112X0 Principles of Family and Human Services in the Standard Course of Study.
- Codes for additional approved Local Course Options were added. These courses have a second character of L.
- Requested codes for courses that are part of Career and College Promise technical pathways were added.
- Technical corrections were made on selected course titles and credit value.
- Collision Repair completer courses were added or renamed for consistency. LEAs must be approved pilots to use these codes.

b) Scheduling Help Workshops

Scheduling Help Sessions are offered to schools who are having difficulty completing the scheduling process. Sessions are face-to-face at the NCDPI Building (301 N Wilmington St. Raleigh, NC) in Room 564. Schools will work with session facilitators to complete their schedules to the extent time allows. Sessions are scheduled for one day, but time of attendance will vary depending on degree of assistance required. Schools may register for one help session only to provide adequate availability for all schools. If after the initial signup period (thru 5/22) seats are available, they will be allotted on a first come, first served basis.

Sessions run from 9-4 each day, with lunch on your own.

Coordinators may register only one person for the workshop to represent the school. Up to 4 people per school may attend with this registration.
