4. Export of Disciplinary Data into NC WISE

NCDPI is planning for the export of disciplinary data from NC WISE and its subsequent import into the USDDC system. This process is scheduled for Monday, December 14, 2009.

During the import process, the Uniform System of Disciplinary Data Collection (USDDC) will be unavailable, starting at 12:00 noon on Monday, December 14. The system should be available by Monday, December 21 at 5 p.m. We will notify you through the NC WISE mailbox once the system is available.

Please be aware that each data transfer will update all previously entered data.

All discipline incidents that are to be uploaded to the USDDC will need to be entered before December 14.

*****NOTE*****

Incidents that do not have a member involved attached will need to be corrected if the incident is to be uploaded.

***** If there is an incident where a member involved can not be identified, the perpetrator section (members involved) Relationship to School should be populated with Unidentified Offender. The last name should be entered as Unknown.

***** Incidents with no members involved attached will not be uploaded

to the USDDC.
