This is a reminder that this coming weekend is a maintenance weekend for NC WISE. Our future maintenance weekends will be broken into two phases. Maintenance for the second phase of systems will begin immediately. All systems will be restored by 6 a.m. on Monday, July 27. If a delay in bringing up the systems should occur, users will be notified via NC WISE email.
