

Overview

- Armed Forces Recruiters request data annually, contact information for Juniors and Seniors
- This information is authorized by the Federal Government
- These requirements are contained in the ESEA (20 U.S.C. § 7908), as amended by the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* (P.L. No. 107-110)
- These requirements are also contained in the *National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002* (P.L. No. 107-107)

Process Details

Data

- Data requested includes *Student Name, Address, Telephone, Grade Level, LEA/School name*
 - The data is used only by the branches of the armed forces.
 - Parents/students may opt out
 - The choice to opt-out can be recorded in eSIS/NC WISE

Process

1. Prior to delivering the data, parents should be informed
 1. Of data delivery and the opt out option
 2. And given a delivery date,
 3. Allowing a period to opt out
2. The data is extracted from eSIS/NC WISE.
3. The extraction does not include data for any student who opted out



Process for 2009-2010

School Year 2009-2010 NC WISE process support

1. An NC WISE Reporting Hub Report will be made available to extract the data for an LEA or for a school.
2. School/LEA extracts the data and delivers this to the armed forces.



Process for 2010-2011

**School year 2010-2011
NC WISE process support**

1. Delivery date will be decided (for the state) prior to school start so parents can be informed in advance with a period to opt out.
2. On the pre-determined date, the information will be extracted for all NC WISE schools and delivered to the Armed Forces
